Resolution #26-CD75C Recommendation of Renaming PS37R to Great Kills High School

The Citywide District 75 Council held a CEC Monthly Meeting on Wednesday, November 28, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. and after reviewing all the evidence and facts, the CD75C passed the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Community Education Council for District 75 hereby approves the support of the proposed new school name for PS37R Annex to the Great Kills High School;

WHEREAS, the members of the CEC Council for District 75 present at this meeting consisted of Joseph Williams-President & Public Advocate Appointee, Maureen Dantzler-2nd Vice President, Gloria Smith-Treasurer, Charlene Carroll-Hall-Council Member, Diamaris Magarin-Council Member and Aliya Rasool-Public Advocate Appointee;

WHEREAS, Chancellor's Regulation # A-860-NAMING AND RENAMING A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL OR A PARTICULAR AREA WITHIN A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL. This regulation provides the rules and procedures that must be followed for the naming and renaming of public schools. It also specifies the rules and procedures to name designated areas of a public school in honor of a donor or grantor or in honor of a deceased person special to the local school community. School facilities, in whole or part, may not be named or renamed under any procedure that deviates from this regulation. Schools may not be named or renamed after living persons. Other than to recognize a grant or donation, particular areas of schools may not be named after living persons;

WHEREAS, Chancellor's Regulation # A-860-NAMING AND RENAMING A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL OR A PARTICULAR AREA WITHIN A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL. Section 8. The community superintendent shall present the proposed name change, along with his/her recommendation, at a public meeting of the appropriate Community Education Council ("CEC"). The CEC must accept public comment in response to the proposed name change and vote on whether to support the proposed name change. The CEC's vote and resulting recommendation shall be duly noted in its minutes of the public meeting;

The CD75C therefore,

RESOLVES, Chancellor's Regulation # A-860-NAMING AND RENAMING A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL OR A PARTICULAR AREA WITHIN A N.Y.C. PUBLIC SCHOOL. Section 9. Be it further resolved that the Community Education Council for District 75 hereby voting process upon majority approval by the council. The appropriate superintendent shall submit the proposed name change and the CEC's recommendation to OFEA for review and approval by the Chancellor or his designee. The superintendent shall use the form entitled "Request to Name a School or to Change the Name of an Existing School" for this purpose (see Attachment No. 1). The request shall: a) indicate the principal's approval; b) include a copy of the minutes indicating the PA's approval and vote; c) indicate the superintendent's recommendation; and d) include a copy of the CEC public meeting minutes indicating its recommendation and vote. Note: schools must follow the foregoing steps and submit a proposed name to DFACE for the Chancellor's approval by March 1st of the year before the proposed

name change is to take effect (for example, a name change for September 2011 must be submitted by March 1, 2010);
