The information here in only represents 251 respondent families of District 75 and has yet to be statistically extrapolated for the entire D75 population




The committee is still trying to get the survey out as much as possible and with your help we can have our parent's voices be heard!



This survey so far has helped the committee members address the concerns of the parents. We have forwarded emails to the appropriate stakeholder(s) to address the needs of the children and parents.






Students Overall experiences with remote Learning


Remote experience by grade






Frequency of Contact from Teachers or Administrators, by School Type












Multilingual Learners: Are remote related services helping your child?

Multilingual Learners: Have you noticed your child regressing?








Multi-Language Learners within D75 Experience

Parents Comments on Noticeable Changes

- ➢ My child is forgetting her teachers' and classmates' names.
- ≻Refusal to do daily routines
- ➢ regressing in academics.
- Self talk and repetitive behaviors
- Does not focus on anything except self-stimulating behavior
- Disinterest/not engaged in remote speech or occupational therapy sessions
- ≻Stopped Toileting

- Pencil grasp, daily meltdowns and regression in writing skills
- ➢ Has lost previously mastered academic skills emotionally fragile
- >He doesn't want to do anything at home, his routine is disrupted
- ≻Yelling, jumping, incoherent babble
- Diminished Speech
- ➢ Behavior and sensory issues
- ➢Increased Aggression

Just a few more comments

*My son is a bit frustrated as he believes the remote learning is fake school. He does the work most of the time and even though multiple teachers have multiple assignments, they say just to do what we can. However, my son sometimes refuses to do anything

*My child is having more behavioral issues tantrums, not sleeping through the night, not eating the same. Does not want to get on the computer to do class assignments

The teachers are excellent. But remote learning is not meant for my son. Learning with a computer is not for him.
