

The committee is still trying to get the survey out as much as possible and with your help we can have our parent's voices be heard.




This survey so far has helped the committee members quickly address the concerns of parents. We have forwarded emails to the appropriate stakeholders to address the needs of the parents.




Frequency of Contact from Teachers or Administrators, by School Type









Bronx: Have one or more of your child's related services failed to start remotely?




Queens: Have one or more of your child's related services failed to start remotely?




Brooklyn: Have one or more of your child's related services failed to start remotely?




Staten Island: Have one or more of your child's related services failed to start remotely?






High School (9-12): Have one or more of your child's related services failed to start remotely?








Student Experiences with Remote Learning




Bronx: Are remote related services helping your child?




Queens: Are remote related services helping your child?






Staten Island: Are remote related services helping your child?




Bronx: Have you noticed your child regressing?




Queens: Have you noticed your child regressing?








High Schools: Are remote related services helping your child?

Some Comments parents made

Things Needed

- Parents claimed they were in need if diapers and wipes.
- Parent claimed she needed Medication and Gluten/casein free foods.
- Parent also claimed that was needed was Diapers and certain foods due to food aversions
- Parents had claimed they didn't receive an iPad yet.

Parents comments on regression

- "He needs school. He is having a difficult time understanding that we must stay home (in our small apartment). He loved school and his school schedule."
- "My son grows frustration and gets very overwhelmed when given an assignment that he does not know how to do because the teacher is not around to physically teach him or video chat to show him how to break down or solve an algebra problem."

Additional Comments



"He cannot use technology. His disabilities are too severe. Remote learning is not appropriate for him. I can only do the work packet. He is bigger and stronger than me. He is regressing and doesn't have the mental capabilities to truly understand what is going on in the world. "



"Does not want to do work in remotely. He's running out of the work packet. I don't a printer to print worksheets. I can't afford a printer".



"Aggression increased, lack of speech, refusal to do daily routines".



"One of my children is now more closed up within herself. No socialization. My other child cannot stay in one place and do one thing for more than 2 minutes. They are both withdrawn from let's say reality"
